

2010 Camellia Sale

This camellia which honors the great North Carolina plantsman has very large, over 5 inch hot red, anemone form flowers in mid-spring. It is a fast-growing bushy evergreen that can reach 15 feet tall and 8' wide.

Shishigashira



Early fall bloomer with small 2.5 to 3 inch, rose red, loose peony form flowers. Slow growth rate with mounding habit that reaches 6 feet tall and 8 feet wide. Small evergreen leaves.

Lady Laura



Variegated rose form, large 3 to 5 inch pink flowers with red stripes blooms in mid-spring stand out against the lustrous dark green leaves. It is a medium growing, bushy evergreen that can reach 15 feet tall and 8 feet wide.

Taylor's Perfection



Semi-double, large 3 to 5 inch, clear pink blooms in mid to late spring. Evergreen, bushy shrub with small leaves and medium growth rate to 15 feet tall and 8 feet wide.

Scentsation



As its name imply, this silvery pink peony form 3 to 5 inch bloom opens in mid-spring and has an added bonus - fragrance. This evergreen grows at a medium rate to a 10 to 12 feet high and 3 to 10 feet wide shrub.

William Lanier Hunt



Early fall blooms are a raspberry shade and 3 to 4 inch loose peony form. The small leaf evergreen grows at a medium rate to a 5 feet tall & 5 feet wide bushy shrub.
