Acoma



Splendid small tree with semipendulous, spreading growth to 10 feet tall. White flowers begin in mid-June and last for 90 days. Foliage turns purple-red in the fall and the tan, cream and light gray bark adds winter interest.

Pink Ruffles



This dwarf, multiple-stemmed shrub stays between 4 to 6 feet tall. It is a heavy bloomer and its light to medium pink flowers open in mid to late summer and last into the fall. This shrub has good powdery mildew resistance.

Chickasaw



Slow-growing miniature that stays less than 2 feet tall is great for small spaces and containers. Compact dense panicles with pink-lavender flowers start blooming in mid to late July. Fine-textured foliage turns bronze-red in the fall.

Pocomoke



Densely branched miniature only grows to 3 feet tall. Single flowers in flattened panicles are deep rose-pink and begin in late July. Great container plant with bronze-red fall foliage. Very good resistance to powdery mildew.

Dynamite



This 20 feet tall tree has vivid true red flowers that begin blooming in early July and last for 100 days. The new foliage is a bright red and the leaves turn orange in the fall. Hardiness and powdery mildew resistance are both very good.

Powhatan



Nice, medium sized tree quickly grows to between 10 and 20 feet tall. Lavender to purple blooms begin in late July and last for 75 days. Foliage turns yellow-orange in the fall with smooth bark. Tree has good resistance to powdery mildew.
